



Rules

1. Each Team must check-in at the main SCYSO tent one hour in a half prior to their first game at the registration tent with the following objects
 - **“Waiver Form” Please make sure to fill out all the paper work completely**
 - **Original Birth Certificate (Player must be Present)**
 - **2 forms of Identification (Original)**
 - **Original game roster**
 - **Rules Signed**
2. Tournament participants are allowed to play with a school I.D., California I.D., credential from own league, Drivers license, Cal South I.D., Passport, US Club Soccer ID etc.
3. Coach must have and maintain original Birth Certificates and Identification to present in case of a protest involving one of your team members.
4. For the women’s open division they must show Identification to be approved to play during the tournament California ID, School ID, League Credential etc.
5. Protest must be done immediately after the game in which you are protesting, in writing with a \$50 deposit at the registration tent
6. Each team must check in to the field 20 minutes before each game and present game roster and player cards to official.
7. 20 minute half 5 min resting period
8. There is NO waiting period after regular scheduled game time
9. All players must play with the same # Jersey through the entire tournament or could result in a suspension for the player
10. Players may only play on one team. They are not allowed to help their Club teams in other divisions.
11. Each team plays 3 games in the first round
12. Games are 11 vs. 11
13. Unlimited player substitution and re-entry (In case a team does not have all 11 players at the beginning of the game, the team may complete its 11 players during the game)
14. A red card results in one game suspension for player/coach
15. Three points for a win one for a tied game
16. In case of a tie in points goal differential applies, if still tied head to head applies, if still tied then who scored more goals applies.
17. Coach is responsible for instructing parents and fans to be 5 feet behind the field line.
18. Officials must be able to identify coach as the only one directing the team
19. Teams, players, fans, coaches, parents could be expelled from the tournament for violent, missed behavior and bad mouthing, with no appeals
20. Girls that are participating in the boys division have a 1 year advantage
21. Each Coach is responsible to CLEAN-UP area AFTER EACH GAME
22. Officials decisions are final- There is no appeals
23. Must play all games scheduled or it can result in an automatic team disqualification from the tournament and \$50 fine.
23. Games that are won by forfeit will result in a 2 goal win for the team that showed up
24. Your team must leave the wristband on for the entire tournament. Taking it off may result in fine. \$1
25. Each coach is responsible to check the official schedule in case of any changes!!
